





Kitty Kat Cabled Hat

Supplies:

Size 8 or 10 round knitting needles One double pointed needle of matching size to use as cable needle Bulky/bulkier yarn of choice

Abbreviations:

P - purl

K - knit

CO - cast on

CN - cable needle

CO 90 sts

Rib: PP, KPK* Repeat rib for 5 rounds

Begin incorporating cable insert into your work, the rounds will be worked PP, KPK, PP, (cable insert)*. Your hat should start with a PP, KPK and end with a cable insert section.

Cable Insert:

Round 1-5: knit 8 sts

Round 6: Slip 4 to CN and hold to the back, knit 4, knit 4 from cable needle

Round 7-12: knit 8 sts

On the first working of the cable knit all rounds as stated above, on the remaining repeats of the cable insert sections skip rounds 4&5. After you have repeated the cable insert 3 times end on row 12 of pattern.

Finishing:

Flip the hat inside out and bind off using the 3 needle bind off technique. Flip the hat right side out again and stitch the "ears" by stitching the hat together in a small diagonal line inside each corner of the hat. Weave in all ends and enjoy!
